Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you for your continued support this week.

Learning

Acorns Class have been exploring measurement using non-standard units, using everyday objects to compare size and length. They have also been learning to identify living and non-living things, helping them to better understand the world around them.

Beech Class have been learning about 3D shapes, identifying their properties and recognising them in the environment. In literacy, they have been writing captions to match images, focusing on clarity and detail. They have also been learning about food chains and how different living things depend on one another.

Laurel Class have been developing their understanding of fractions in maths. In literacy, they have been working on persuasive writing, using language to present strong arguments. They have also been practising a range of playground games, building teamwork and cooperation skills.

Oak Class have been working on number sequences, identifying patterns and predicting what comes next. In literacy, they have been exploring informal and formal language and when to use each. They have also continued their work on biographies of Mary Anning, learning about her important contributions to science.
